Covid-19 Facility Use Safety Protocols

During this time of the Covid-19 pandemic, it is essential to do all that is possible to maintain safety protocols particular when it comes to building use as. To that end any group wishing to use the church's facility MUST agree to follow ALL of these safety protocols:

- 1) All participants should AFFIRM the following before being permitted to enter the building:
 - The individual has taken her or his temperature shortly before arrival at the church and her or his temperature is below 100.4 F.
 - The individual is not experiencing any symptoms associated with Covid-19, such as Fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, new loss of smell or taste, diarrhea, or vomiting.
 - The individual has not been previously diagnosed with, or suspected to have, Covid 9 and has been completely symptom free for at least 72 hours without the aid of any medication.
 - The individual has not been exposed within the past 14 days to anyone diagnosed with, or suspected to have, Covid-19.
 - The individual has not traveled within the past 14 days either internationally or to any domestic location outside of Ohio.
- 2) Masks which cover the mouth and nose for all individuals. Any person failing to wear a mask MUST be asked to leave immediately. If the individual refuses, the activity MUST be terminated immediately.
- 3) Attendance MUST be taken at all meetings in the building. Contact information MUST be obtained for each person in attendance in the event it is necessary to contact attendees regarding possible exposure to Covid-19.
- 4) Physical distancing is MANDATORY, in ADDITION to the use of masks. Six foot is a MINIMUM, not a guideline. As with masks, if an individual refuses to comply, the person MUST leave, or the activity MUST immediately be terminated.
- 5) NO meeting shall exceed 60 MINUTES.
- 6) Groups MUST provide BOTH hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes for use.
- 7) Prior to leaving, groups MUST clean up AND sanitize any room or building equipment that they have used.
